

Sponsored walk 18.09.2021

The sponsored walk focuses on Brighton and Hove and will stop at the two Basque ninos' colonies and seven addresses where Brigaders volunteered from or, in one case, was a volunteer's birthplace.

We should aim to stop at each venue for approximately 15 minutes, to read out some information about the place, its importance, memoirs of ninos or a bit about the Brigader who lived there.

We may wish to spend a little longer at some venues, so the estimated completion time may be later than stated here.

Here are the timings, distances and stops:-

START:

POINT 1: **Hove Station** Meet outside the front (south entrance) at 11am.
Depart **Hove Station** for **Conway Street** at 11.15am
Distance: 0.2miles Duration: 10minutes

POINT 2 **ETA: 11.25am**
Point of interest: **Brigader Arthur George Hirst** lived at **No.66 Conway Street**. House demolished to make way for a bus garage.
11.40am Depart: **Conway Street** for **Alpine Road** via Montgomery Street
Distance: 0.7miles Duration: 15 minutes

POINT 3 **ETA: 12pm**
Point of interest: **Brigader Roy Watts** was born at **No. 35 Alpine Road**
12.15pm Depart: **Alpine Road** for **Girton House**
Distance: 0.9miles Duration: 25 minutes

POINT 4 **ETA: 12.40pm** **Girton House**
Point of interest: **Basque children's colony**
12.50pm Depart: **Girton House** for **Norton Road** via Seafield Road and
Church Road
Distance: 0.9 miles Duration: 20 minutes

POINT 5 **ETA: 13.10pm**
Point of interest: **Brigader Philip Patrick Wilmot** lived at **11a Norton Road**
13.25pm Depart: **Norton Road** for **The Pines, Furze Hill**
Distance: 1 mile Duration: 21 minutes

POINT 6 **ETA: 13.45pm**
Point of interest: Basque children's colony then known as **Aylesbury House**
2pm Depart: **The Pines** for **St. Ann's Well Gardens Café**
Distance: 0.2miles **REFRESHMENT STOP: 45 minutes**

2.45pm Depart: **Café** for **Rosehill Terrace** via Yorke Avenue and Davigdor Road
Distance: 0.9miles Duration: 30 minutes

POINT 7 **ETA: 3.15pm**
Point of interest: **Brigader Vincent Deegan lived at No. 36 Rosehill Terrace** (now demolished to make way for flats)
3.30pm Depart: for **Whitecross Street** via New England Street
Distance: 0.4miles Duration: 10 minutes

POINT 8 **ETA: 3.40pm**
Point of interest: Brigader Robert Jasper lived at **No.15 Whitecross Street** (demolished)
4pm Depart: for **Upper Rock Gardens** via A23 and Edward Street
Distance: 0.9miles Duration: 20 minutes

POINT 9 **ETA: 4.20pm**
Point of interest: **Brigader William Sill lived at No.25 Upper Rock Gardens**
4.35pm Depart: **Upper Rock Gardens** for **Eaton Place** via St.James Street
Distance: 0.7miles Duration: 15 minutes

POINT 10 **ETA: 4.50pm**
Point of interest: **Brigader Donald McDonald lived at No. 3b Eaton Place**

Walk ends approx. **5.10pm**

Approximate total distance: 7 miles Duration of walk: 6hrs 10min (including refreshment stop)

Walkers coming from London should book through to Hove, although they may wish to return from Brighton Station: Distance: 1.6miles Duration of walk 34 minutes or you may wish to catch a bus.
